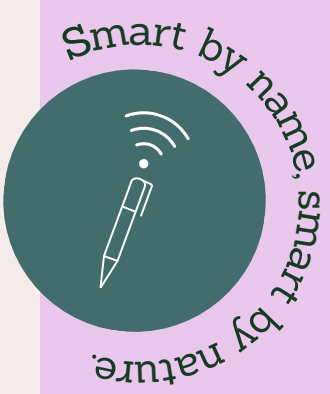

What is NFC?

Near Field Communication (NFC) is a wireless technology that allows devices to exchange information when they are brought close together, usually within a few centimetres.

Most modern smartphones already have NFC built in, which means they can instantly interact with NFC-enabled products with a simple tap. There's no need for apps, scanning, or typing in web addresses — just tap and the connection happens automatically.

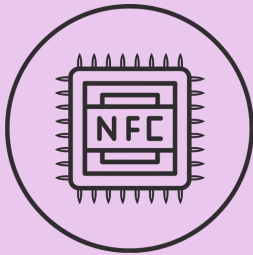
When a phone touches an NFC-enabled item, such as an NFC pen, the tiny chip inside the product sends a pre-programmed action to the phone. This could open a website, display a digital business card, launch a video, etc. The process happens in seconds, creating a quick and seamless way to move people from a physical product to digital content.

NFC is already used widely in everyday life through contactless payments, access cards, transport tickets, and smart devices. When integrated into promotional products like pens, it becomes a powerful marketing tool. One simple tap can deliver information, share content, and create an interactive experience, turning a regular promotional item into a smart connection point between brands and their audience.

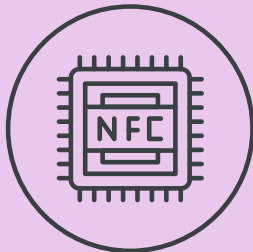


How the NFC pen works?

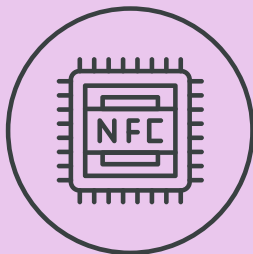

NFC works through a small microchip and antenna that communicate with nearby devices using short-range radio frequency signals.

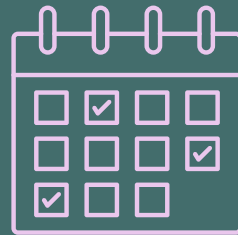
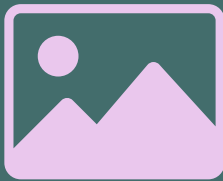
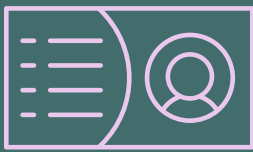


When an NFC-enabled smartphone comes within a few centimetres of an NFC tag, such as the chip inside an NFC pen, the phone generates a low-power electromagnetic field.



This field activates the NFC tag and allows the two devices to exchange data using radio waves operating at 13.56 MHz. Once the smartphone detects the tag, its NFC reader scans the chip's data using the NFC Data Exchange Format (NDEF), then triggers the programmed action automatically.

- 2** Insurance & Finance - Advisers often meet clients face-to-face, making NFC pens a simple way to share contact details, appointment booking pages, or policy information. One tap can send clients directly to an application form or financial guide.
- 3** Events & Conferences - At trade shows and networking events, NFC pens act as smart giveaways. When someone taps the pen, it can open a landing page, portfolio, event information, or sign-up form, turning a simple promo item into a lead generator.
- 4** Automotive - Car dealerships and vehicle sales teams can link NFC pens to vehicle listings, booking pages for test drives, or promotional offers. A quick tap can show customers specs, videos, and finance options.
- 5** Education & Training - Universities, training providers, and course educators can link NFC pens to course information, enrolment pages, student portals, or digital resources, making them a great tool for open days and student recruitment events.

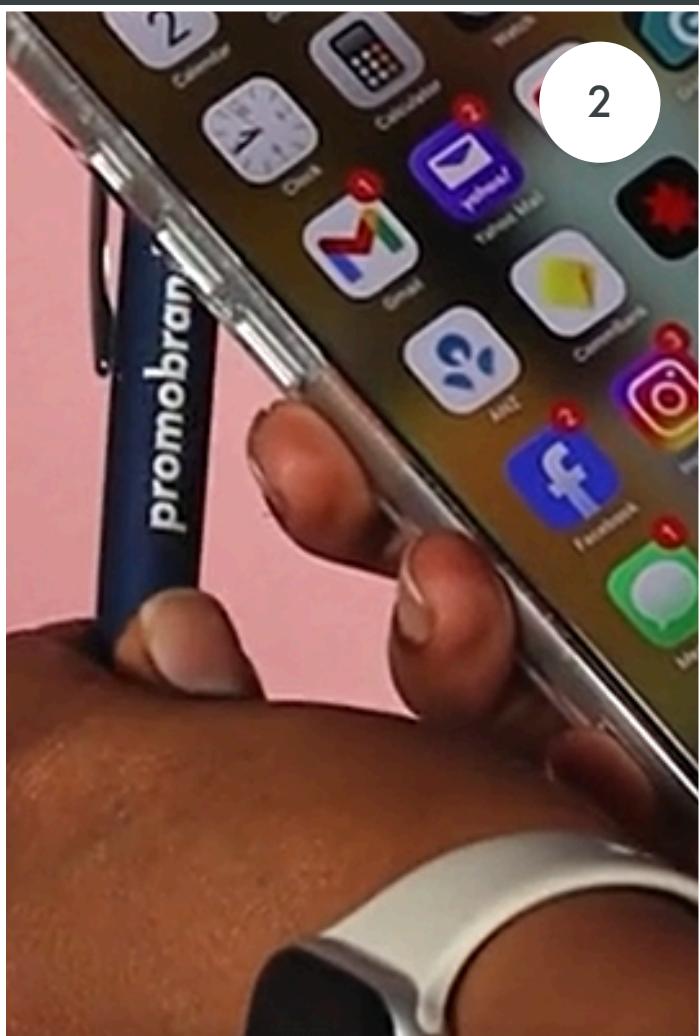

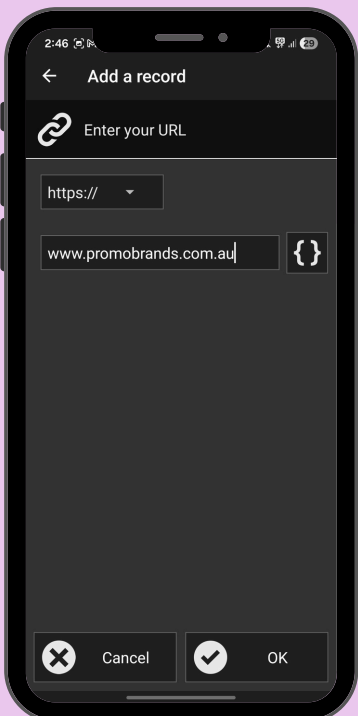
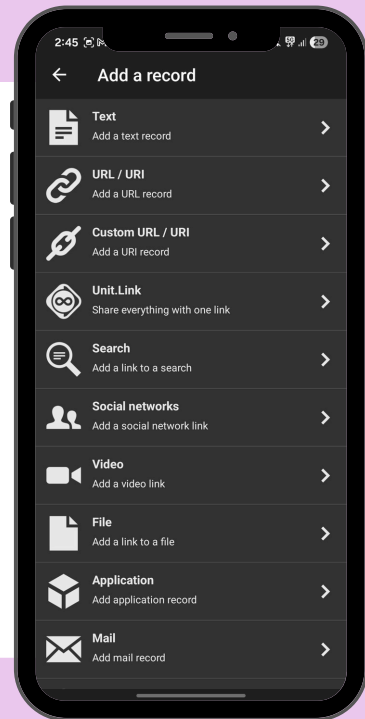


Tap the "WRITE" tab. Then tap the "ADD A RECORD" button

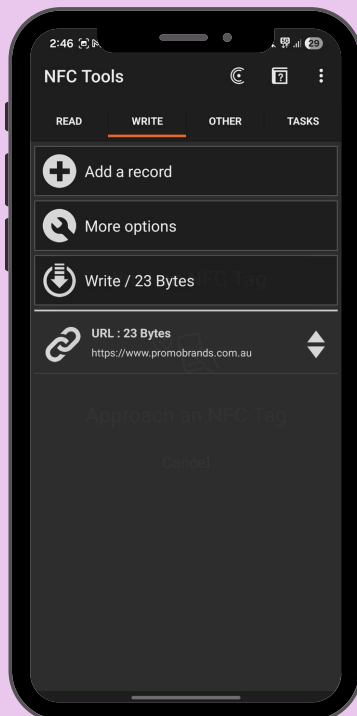
Find the NFC Tools app on your App store. Install it and open it



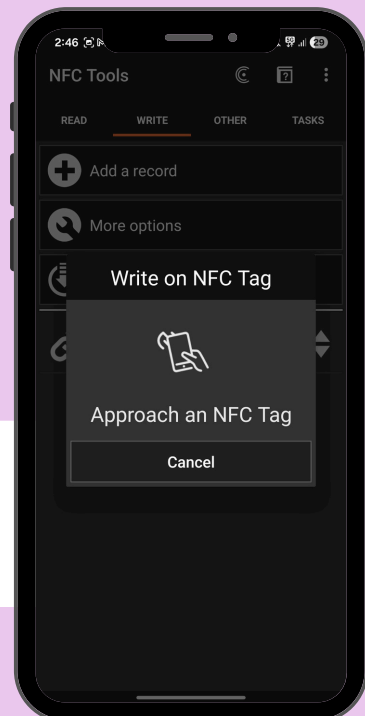
There are many options here to choose from including website, videos, locations, images, files, and a lot more. For this example, we are going to click on URL/URI to link a website.

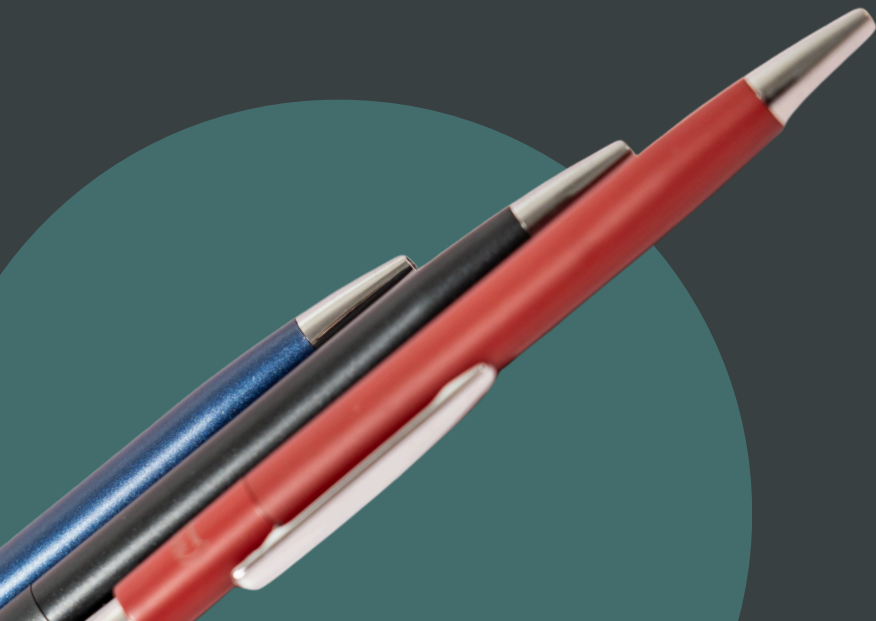
